Program Timeline and Implementation

Applications opens Friday, October 17, 2025, with sponsor invoices scheduled for early January 2026. The selection process involves collaboration between Pantoro representatives and WA Mining Club selection panels to identify the most suitable scholarship recipient based on academic record, personal circumstances, and industry commitment.
